Harlequin reopens the State Theater with an immersive Cabaret

Olympia, WA – May 21, 2024 – Harlequin Productions presents *Cabaret,* the Tony, Olivier and Academy-Award-winning musical by John Kander, Fred Ebb and Joe Masteroff, June 28 – July 28, 2024 at the State Theater in downtown Olympia, WA. Producing Artistic Director Aaron Lamb will direct.

In a time when the world is changing forever, there is one place where everyone can be free. Welcome to the Kit Kat Klub.

One of the most famous American musicals of all time, Cabaret takes us to the seedy underground of 1929 Berlin during the twilight of the Jazz Age. Hit songs include "Willkommen", "Don't Tell Mama," "Maybe This Time" and, of course, the title song, "Cabaret."

Since its 1966 Broadway debut, *Cabaret* has been revived multiple times on the West End and Broadway, most recently in the 2021 West End revival starring Eddie Redmayne, which just opened on Broadway this April. Tracing the fall of the Weimar Republic to Hitler's Nazi dictatorship from the perspective of Berlin's artists, *Cabaret* uniquely captures a fragile moment of borrowed time, which has proved fertile ground for creative reinvention as well as an opportunity to draw parallels with current affairs. Reflecting these ideas, Mr. Lamb writes:

To me, *Cabaret* is three things. First, it is a celebration. A celebration of individuality, of idealism, of modernity and progress. Sexual freedom, gender parity, equity and equality were at the forefront of Weimar culture, as they are now. In many ways it was a remarkably similar time. Next, *Cabaret* is a journey. A journey through 1930s Berlin, through a motley cast of characters who turn out to be remarkably like us. Finally, *Cabaret* is a warning. It's a warning as to what can happen when we're not paying attention.

Cabaret marks the first Harlequin production at the State Theater since the building closed in February 2024 for an extensive renovation. The finished product will be on full display: one hour before each performance, audiences will enter through the new backstage door on Washington Street and tour the space while enjoying immersive preshow entertainment. For patrons interested in continuing the immersive experience,

seven onstage VIP tables are available each night. For a \$45 upcharge, two VIP patrons will be served an appetizer of their choice from Uptown Grill and a bottle of sparkling wine.
