Aaron's storytelling captured the heart of Dickens' vision, and his adaptation has been the guiding light for me this year. I've sought to honour the tradition he established, while also offering my own spin on the iconic story. You'll see refreshed scenery, new projections and costumes, a revamped script, added characters, and enhanced lighting, sound, and special effects. I hope you'll be delighted by the differences but still feel the comfort of the familiar."
